INCLEMENT WEATHER VEHICLE PARKING POLICY.

If inclement weather is possible or imminent, the City Streets Superintendent or his representative may declare a weather parking order. The order will be announced on area media and available by calling the Auburn Police Department. The order will include the beginning date and time and the ending date and time. As the weather changes, the order may be shortened or extended by the City Streets Superintendent or his representative with all changes announced on area media and available by calling the Auburn Police Dept.

A. During the time of the order, **no** vehicles, including but not limited to cars, trucks, boats, any and all trailers, or equipment, may be parked on city right-of-way. The city right-of-way shall include both paved and unpaved areas of the right-of-way including the shoulder.

B. Failure to adhere to the weather parking order will result in the vehicle or vehicles being ***towed*** at the owner's expense and a ***fine of \$25.00 per vehicle***. All police officers employed by the City are empowered to enforce this prohibition.
